Medical Practitioners to get their name renewed as prescribed under section 19 of the Karnataka Medical Registration Act 1961. Section 19 of the Karnataka Medical Registration Act, 1961 is extracted for reference:

19. Renewal of registration-(1) Not withstanding anything contained in section 13, each medical practitioner shall pay to the Medical Council on or before the thirty-first day of December of

every year, a renewal fee of two rupees for the continuance of his name in the register. (2) If the renewal fee is not paid before the due date, the Registrar shall remove the name of the defaulter from the register: Provided that the name so removed may be re-entered in the

register on payment of the renewal fee in such manner and subject to such conditions, as may be prescribed by rules. As per Amendment of KMR Act in 2003, Section 19 - In Section 19 of the principal Act:-

(I) in sub-section (1), for the words "on or before the thirty first day of December of every year a renewal fee of two rupee" the words "a prescribed fee on or before such date as may be prescribed"

shall be substituted. Prescribed fee by Council is Rs.1.000/- and prescribed date is 31st December every five years.
