
Sir,

With reference to your letter dated 31st July, 2009 addressed to the President of the Council, it is stated that as per the current provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, registration once granted and consequential entry in the Indian Medical Register or the doctor in accordance with Section 15, 21, 23 & 27 is permanent for life time and it does not require either attendance in CME programmes or periodical renewal of registration.

The Council has recommended to the Central Government with attendance in Continuing Medical Education Programmes and renewal of registration every 5 years be made mandatory by suitably amending the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 wayback in 1997. Till date, the Central Government has not introduced these amendments in the Parliament.

Hence, the provisions as enshrined in the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 are prevalent on date.
